In the name of God amen. I make Mathew of Halifax County being in perfect senses mind and memory do make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner and form as follows Viz.

I give and bequeath to my son Secundus Mathew one shawl more

I give and bequeath to my son Mark Mathews one bay horse called Rand Abells

I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Sally Mathews one Negro fellow Will and one Negro Wench named Benk and three horse hind and all my stock of both kind and I bequeath during her life and after her decease to be equally divided amongst all my children Likewise as my will and desire that all the remaining part of my Estate may be equally divided between my children to wit Secundus & Nancy and Mark & Hartwell & Betsey and Sally Mathews

Lastly I appoint and ordain my friend Arthur Davis and Goodwin Davis my whole and sole Executor of this my last will and testament hereunto I have set my hand and seal this 25 day of February 1791
