In the name of God Amen! I Gideon Mathews of the State
of North Carolina and County of Halifax being weak and lame in Bodily health
but in perfect sound mind and memory nowe it is appointed for all to
die in order to dispose of my worldly estate which it hath pleased God
to bestowe on me I do this seventeenth day of march in the year
of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and fifteen make and ordain
this to be my last will and Testiment in the manner and form following
that is to say — First Ileand to my beloved wife Charlotte Mathews
the use of my plantation together with the ballance of my other Lands dur-
ing her natural life in order for her to raise my four Children (viz) /
Anne Mathews, Baldy Mathews, James Mathews, and John Mathews;
also Ileand to my wife Charlotte Mathews my negro girl Charity together
with my old mare and two cows and yearlings and two ewes and Lambs
with all my corn and fodder and wheat and two Sows and eight shoats and
all my plantation tools with all my house hold and Kitchen Furniture (ex-
cept such as her after Excepted) for the use of said Property for my
wife Charlotte Mathews to keep together and have my four children above
mentiond and give them a reasonable eddication in schooling — and at the
Death of my wife Charlotte Mathews or whenever she may be about to waste
the said Property lent, or to cause the same to be wasted or to be removed or
about to be removed from this Country or suffers my children before mentiond
to be wilfully abused — Then it is my will and desire that all the least Prop-
erty be equally diuided among my four Children (viz) Anne Mathews
Baldy Mathews, James Mathews and John Mathews then it is my
will and desire that all the balane of my property not before left
be sold and the money arising therefrom together with the Dels that are
due me — after paying my just debts be equally diuided between my
four children above mentioned — Then I nominate and appoint my
friend Isham Matthews Executor to this my last will and Testiment
I also nominate and appoint my friend Isham Matthews Guardian to my four
my four children (viz) Anne Mathews, Baldy Mathews, James Mathews
and John Mathews — As witness whereof I have set my hand and seal this

In the name of God amen; I Thomas Nichols of Halifax County North Carolina, being of sound mind and memory do make and ordain this my Last will and Testament. —

First I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Sarah Nichols all the property which I now possess or hereafter may possess during her natural life, and after her death to descend to my daughter Belinda Carlisle and her heirs forever. —

And lastly I give and bequeath to my grandson Caleb Butts Five Shillings to be paid out of such property as my wife has a possession after said Caleb arrives of Legal age. —
