to be Buried in decent Christian Burial at the
Discretion of my Executors Nothing doubting but
at the General Resurrection I shall receive the
same again, by the mighty Power of God
and as touching such Worldly Estate wherewith
It has pleased God to bless me in this life
I Give Demise & Dispose of the same in the
following manner I Give - First I give and
Bequeath unto my Wife Ann Mathews a
Sufficient Maintenance upon the plantation
where I now live during her life or Widowhood
Then I Give & Bequeath unto my son Richard
Mathews the said plantation & improvements where
I now live being 250 Acres of Patent Land
also 100 Acres of Patent Land on the South
side of Little Fishing Creek to him & his
Heirs for ever - Then I give & Bequeath
unto my Daughter Susanna Mathews Two
hundred & thirty three Acres of Land joining
Wm. Kelley's land & Isaac Brant's to her & her
Heirs for ever - And I Give & Bequeath

 Item I give & Requeth unto my Daughter

 Amable, one Negro fellow named Caesar and
 one Negro woman named Jean to him & his heirs

 Grand Daughter Delilah Mathews one Negro
 Girl named Pats to her & her heirs for ever —
 Item I give & Requeth unto my son Richard
 Mathews the Mill and my riding Horse
 to him & his heirs for ever — Item I give &
 & Requeth unto my son in Law William Pully
 the son of Ten Shillings Virginia Money, also
 unto my Grand son Thomas Pully the sum of
 Ten Shillings Virginia Money. — Item I
 Give & Requeth the Houses, Cattle, Hogs &
 Household Goods that I am possessed with
 to be equally divided by two Men, to James
 Mathews, Susannah Mathews, Jeremiah Mathews
 Richard Mathews & Delilah Mathews to them
 & their heirs for ever — I do Ordain Constituted
 & appoint my el. Richard Mathews

 named Mills & Request the
 this, and no other to be my last Will & Testament,
 In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my
 hand and seal the 19th day of November in
 the Year of our Lord ~~1773~~ 1773
