and form following:

First - My will & desire is that my just debts be first paid & satisfied -
Second - I give & bequeath to my three youngest Daughters viz - Cecilia R. West & Anna
Gough Anne Whetstone all my property of every kind and description with its increase share and
share alike to them and their heirs and assigns for ever but in case either of my said three
named Daughters should die before they arrive to the age of Twenty one years without leavefull
issue, the property to pass to the surviving two or else leavefull issue, and if two die before they come
to the age of Twenty one years having no leavefull issue, the property to go to the surviving one or else
leavefull issue, and if all three should die having no leavefull issue, then and my Bequest to my
two oldest Daughters viz - Martha & Fannie and Elizabeth G. Grant and after their Deaths all
said property to go one half to the children of my said Daughter Martha and the other half
to the children of said Daughter Elizabeth -

Third - My will & desire is that my Executor herein afterwards, make such alterations
or changes in my property either by selling & buying and the like as he may conceive necessary
and best for the mutual convenience and benefit & advantage of my said three youngest
Daughters Cecilia, West, and Gough Anne their Education &c -

Hartly - I do hereby nominate Candidate and appoint my living Brother David Cappell
whole sole Executor of this my last will & Testament - bearing my hand and seal this

North Carolina being in perfect soundness of mind do make and ordain this my
last will & testament -

Item - I bind to my beloved wife Rebekah Partin the sum of and plantation
wherein I may live with all the utensiles and all my Household & Kitchen furniture
During her life or widowhood, and the following articles, my Stock of Horses, Cattle, Hogs,
and Sheep, my wish is that she should have the use of those things above mentioned
For the express purpose of raising my small children under age, also my wish is
that my wife Rebekah should give to my sons except Lipe one Horse as they come
of ages; or she can with the help of their assistance raise for them without Injuring
the Olphins, 30 Bush, William, Dick, Allen, Berg & David, Nelson James Henry;
and my wish is if she should fail to give those horses as they require, that at
her Marriage or Death that they should Rec^d. Forty Dollars out of my Estate
more than the rest of my children, with my Land equally divided among
the above mentioned boys except Lipe, which I give one Mare 1 Bush two
Sows and Pigs 1 Cow and Lamb which I before left to him in the rest of my
property after my beloved Marriage or Death I wish to be equally Divided among
all my living Children and their Heirs. I also appoint testate and Ordaine
my dear Lipe Partin and Allen Partin sole Executors to this my last will
and Testament whatsoever, as witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and seal this 17th Day of October 1818.
